Product Description

The color video doorphone can be used to call, intercom and control electric door lock and it also can be applied to monitor outside for 24 hours, giving you the combined benefit of security and convenience. It is equipped with SD card to save video recording and pictures atomatically. It is a product that very suitable for villa, single house, hotel, office etc.

Safety Instruction

- Keep the indoor unit away from high temperature such as near an oven or in direct sunlight, and high humidity such as bathroom and greenhouse.
- Do not install the indoor unit close to a television the signals the TV and the Intercom use can be interfered with each other.
- Do not touch the unit with wet hands.
- Clean the camera or screen with a soft cloth. Do not use detergent, thinner, volatile or corrossive liquid.

Avoid throwing dropping or hitting the units.

- Do not expose the camera of the outdoor unit to direct sunlight.
- Use the product under the circumstance of barrier-free and no inteference.
- Avoid power off when recording, otherwise the data world be lost easily.


Caution

- 1. To prevent damage, the adapter should be fasten on the wall according to instruction.
- 2. Power plug as disconnecting device should be kept convenient to operate.
- 3. When connecting AC power line, please plug in the power after the line is connected


System Installation

A.Outdoor Unit

① Fix the unit 1.4m - 1.7m high from the ground (according to the camera effect) so as to avoid direct sunshine.







② Drill two proper holes in the wall, and fasten the rain shade on the wall with screws.





- ③ Refer to the wiring diagram to do the wire connection.
- 4) Fix the outdoor unit on the rain shade with screws.





⑤ Plug up the screw holes with silicone caps.



B. Indoor Unit


- (1) Fasten the bracket on the wall with screws.
- ② Hang the unit on the bracket after finishing the connection. Plug the two ends of the jack of the power adapter into the sockets of AC power and the unit respectively. (See wiring diagram1 and 2).






C.Wiring Diagram

Cable Lengthening Configuration

- Enclosed cable length is 15m, if the user wants to lengthen the cable into 15m 50m, use RVV4 x 0.5mm² connecting wire.
- Connect the wiring terminals 1 2 3 4 of indoor unit with wiring terminals 1 2 3 4 of outdoor unit respectively.
- The wiring terminals 5,6 of indoor unit or outdoor unit are connected with electric-controlled door lock through RVV2X1.0mm². The wiring terminals of 7&8 are connected with gate outdoor lock, only switching signal is provided.

SD Card Instructions For Use





Professional SD card


An SD card slot on the back of the indoor unit is used to insert the SD card. You can use the SD card to store video file, it is recommended to use professional SD card and supports 32GB maximum capacity. In power-off status, insert the SD card along the expansion slot (with patterned side facing users), then gently push the card into the slot and indicating sound will be heard. If you want to remove the SD, just simply press the SD card again, no start-up software is needed.(Attention: power off status is needed for the operation).

A.VIDEO INTERCOM

- 1. The indoor unit will ring when someone presses the button of outdoor unit, and the screen will display the image of visitor and start recording automatically with date REC 00:00:00. Press button to have the intercom, the talking can last for 120 seconds, press again to finish the intercom. If no one answers the call after 60 seconds, the indoor monitor will return to the standby mode, displaying perpetual calendar and digital clock. (Attention: Built-in four chord melody rings or downloaded MP3 for options)
- 2. Press MONITOR button in the standby mode to monitor the outside, you can see the outside and hear the sound from outside, but the outside can not hear the sound from inside. Press MONITOR again to return to standby mode displaying perpetual calendar and clock.
- 3. Press UNLOCK button to release the electric door lock. (external power supply is needed to connect outdoor unit with electric lock, meanwhile, indoor unit should not be connected with electric lock. More details please refer to the wiring diagram)
- 4. Press GATE OUTDOOR UNLOCK to release the gate door lock.
- 5. Press (♠) to enter rings selection menus. Press (+/-) to choose rings. If there are too many rings inside, you can press (♠) or (▶) to seek quickly and press (▶) to select the song as the ring and finally press (♦) to turn back to main menus. (Attetion: The rings' name shall be in the same language of the machine, if the machine is in English, the name of ring shall be English or digits, otherwise it may fail to display.
- 6. Use TALK VOLUME to adjust the volume of intercom.
- 7. Use BRIGHTNESS and CHROMA to adjust how light the image appears and how much color is in the image respectively. (Attention: brightness and chroma can not be adjusted while playing recordings)
- 8. Please take off the protective film for best performance.

B.VIDEO RECORDING

- 1.Press() button on perpetual calendar interface and adjust the brightness and chroma first, pay attention that it is impossible to adjust the brightness and chroma when playing the video record.

C. PLAY VIDEO RECORDING

- 1.Press (Q)on perpetual calendar interface, all video recordings on SD card will show chronologically. The unread recording will be showed on top with "***NEWREC**************. avi". The read ones will be marked with "***REC****************. avi". When you choose (+/-) to select the file you want to read, if there are too many files, you can press "up"or "down" to seek quickly and then press (▶||) to play the recording. If the current video is finished it will continue to play the next video. All the video will be played one by one and start from the first video after a circulation. During the play, press (▶||) to stop playing and press it again to continue the playing.
- 2.Press (▶) and (▶) to turn pages and press (+/-) to choose the video record.

- 3.Press () during the play to play next video record.
- 4. Press (during the play to play previous video record.
- 5. Press (Q) during the play to return to the video record list.
- 6.Press ()during the play to return to the perpetual calendar interface.
- 7.On perpetual calendar interface, press (Q) to display all of the recorded video files and press (⊙) to enter into deleting menus.

 Press (+/-) to choose to whether delete the selected file or not and then press (▶|) ro confirm it.

D.TIME SETTING

Press" \bigcirc " on the perpetual calendar interface to enter into the interface of time setting, press it again to choose YEAR,MON,DAY,HOUR,MIN or SEC, then press (+) and (-) to set the exact value, press (|-|) to confirm the modification, press (-|-|) to exit after the setting.

E.SD CARD FORMATTING

Hold (\mathfrak{S}) for 5s on perpetual calendar interface to enter into the SD card formatting status, press(+) and(-) to choose Y/N, press(|) to confirm the formatting. Press(\mathfrak{S}) to exit after the setting.

F. MP3 setting

In the perpetual calendar interface, press the right (\Longrightarrow) to enter MP3 setting mode. Press (+/-) to choose rings, press (\blacktriangleright I) to confirm and press (\lessapprox) to turn back when finished; if the selected rings need to be deleted, press (\circledcirc) to enter into deleting interface and press (+/-) to choose Yes/No to delete the ring. If choosing Yes, then press (\blacktriangleright II) to delete it. (Attention: rings in 000-004 can not be deleted.)

G.Screen saver picture playing setting

In the perpetual calendar interface, Press(\blacktriangleright II) set the playing time of screen saver picture, press(+/-) to set the time(max 30s), for example to set 10s, 10s later in standby mode, it starts playing screen saver picture; if set 0s, it becomes black screen 1min later. Press the buttons on the left,

it will enter into the displaying state. Pictures support JPG fomat, max 20,000,000 pixels, larger than that can not be displayed. Meanwhile, the pictures' name shall be in the same language of the machine, if the machine is in English, the name of picture shall be English or digits, otherwise it may fail to display.

H. Motion detector setting

- Hold() for 5s in standby mode displaying perpetual calendar and digital clock to enter into the interface of motion detector setting.
- 1. Sensitivity setting: H/M/L three levels, press button(▶) towards lower sensitivity and(▶) towards higher sensitivity.
- 2. Turn motion detector on/off: press(+) to turn on and (−) to turn off, then press(►) to confirm the setting.
- 3. When the motion is turned off, only when visitor presses the call button shall the video recording function work.

I. Multi-media function

- 1. With SD card reader, you can upload JPG screen saver pictures into the unit or download video recordings from the unit.
- 2.Put the SD card into card reader and connect to computer, if it indicates successful connection, click my computer twice and you will find a removable disk ,

click it twice and you will find the following files:

- iVideo Is used to store all the recordings
- PIC is used to store JPG screen saver pictures
- ring is used to store Mp3

Note:put SD card into indoor unit and then put out, the SD card will creat the three files above.

Trouble Shooting

Problem	Solutions
No Video/Audio	 Make sure all the connections are secured and properly connected. Make sure there is nothing obstructing the view of the camera. Check if the speaker is damaged.
No Video, but intercommunication is normal	 Make sure all the connections are secured and properly connected. Make sure there is nothing obstructing theview of the camera.
No Audio when calling	 Make sure the volume notch on the indoor unit is turned up. Make sure that there is nothing interfering with the speaker or microphone on the indoor unit or the camera. Make sure all the connections are secured and properly connected.
The outdoor unit can not call the indoor unit	Make sure all the connections are secured and properly connected.
Door Unlock not Functioning	 Make sure the connections with the locks are secured and properly connected. Make sure you have the lock wired to a power source enough to make it operate.
No one can hear me outside but I can hear them after calling	Press TALK key for two-way intercom Make sure all the connections are secured and properly connected
I can hear outside, but outdoor unit can not hear indoor unit when monitoring	 Press TALK key to make sure intercoming for only pressing monitor button will stop the sound of indoor unit transmitting to outdoor. Check that the wiring is correct or not and whether is pluged stably.
Auto-recording function is not working when there is someone moving in frontof the outdoor camera	 Press Time button to check whether you have turned the motion sensor off. Make sure the SD card is well inserted.
